Review fees are charged for new project initial reviews, continuing and independent annual reviews performed by the GBMC IRB, and reviews for projects ceded to an external IRB.

## Fee Schedule for New Projects Approved After July 1, 2024

The fees collected vary according to the type of review (e.g. full board, expedited, ceded) as follows:

Review fees apply to the following individuals who use the GBMC IRB to review their research:

- 1. Non-GBMC employed medical staff affiliates
- 2. Non-GBMC affiliated individuals in cooperation with a GBMC employed liaison

Review fees are waived for all employees of GBMC and its subsidiaries conducting research as part of their employment with the following exception:

--A review fee will be charged out for the initial review of new funded projects where the sponsor has made provision in the project budget for the reimbursement of IRB review fees.

Review fees are automatically waived for residents, fellows and other graduate students affiliated with GBMC and its subsidiaries.

All fees collected from non-GBMC employed/affiliated individuals must be in the form of a check (payable to GBMC IRB). No cash or charge payments will be accepted. Payment is due upon receipt of invoice. IRB review fees are not refundable.

All fees charged out to departments conducting sponsored research subject to an initial, new project review fee shall be paid by way of an interdepartmental fund transfer.

The fee schedule shall be subject to change without advance notice by a majority vote of the convened IRB.
